Who is providing this notice?	Second Half Financial Partners, L.L.C, a registered investment advisor.
Why?	Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.
What?	The types of personal information we collect and share depend on the product or service you have with us. This information can include:  • Social Security number and investment experience  • Income and risk tolerance  • Assets and account transactions  When you are no longer our client, we continue to share your information as described in this notice.
How?	All financial companies need to share customers' personal information to run their everyday business. ## WHAT WE DO

How does Second Half protect my personal information? To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include computer safeguards and secure files and buildings.

What happens when I limit sharing for an account I hold jointly with someone else?	Your choices will apply to everyone on your account.

DEFINITIONS	
Affiliates	Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.
Nonaffiliates	Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.  • Second Half does not share with nonaffiliates so that they can market to you.
Joint Marketing	A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you.  • Second Half doesn't jointly market.
